POLICY

Qualifications for Executive Officers:

All executive officers of AAI shall meet the following qualifications at the time of their elections or appointment:

1. One year of membership in Overeaters Anonymous,
2. Six months of current, continuous direct participation in the activities of AAI, and
3. Six months of continuous recovery in Overeaters Anonymous as evidenced by:
 - a. Six months current continuous abstinence; and
 - b. Physical, emotional and spiritual recovery as a result of working the Twelve Steps.

If no qualified candidate for an office can be found, the members may waive any or all of these qualifications.

No person who holds any office in another Intergroup of Overeaters Anonymous, or who represents another Intergroup at World Service Conference or a Regional Assembly may concurrently serve as an Officer of AAI.

Executive Officers meet (via e-mail, face-to-face, telephone, or other available means) before the scheduled IG meeting to discuss the agenda. The agenda will be available to all members of AAI. Motions are put on the agenda by an executive officer.
